ANNUAL REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2020-21 TO 2023-24

Poornaprajna Samshodhana Mandiram is the brain child of H.H. Sri Sri Vishveshatirtha Swamiji of Sri Pejavara Matha, Udupi. It is a pioneer Research Institute - a class by itself.

The main purpose of Revered Swamiji is to provide every facility for those who are interested in Sanskrit literature and to provide all that is needed for a systematic and comparative study of all schools of thought of Indian philosophy, in order to continue and uphold the rich heritage of Indian philosophy. As a part of this programme, collection of rare manuscripts, preserving, publishing books so far unpublished and printing of rare works in Sanskrit, Kannada and English for the propagation of ancient thought throughout the length and breadth of this country, have been taken up.

With this view-point Revered Swamiji started Poornaprajna Samshodhana Mandiram as a model research institute in 1988. Considering the progress made, the Union Ministry of Human Resource Development, New Delhi has recognised this institute and included it in the prestigious group of Rashtriya Sanskrit Samsthan (presently Deemed University) by granting financial aid from 1994, for its all-round development. This Research institute has been fully utilising this aid by achieving its purpose.

- 1. Collection of rare manuscripts.
- Preservation of manuscripts and precious books.
- Critically editing the works, rectifying errors and getting them ready for publication.
